

Course description:

The **'Skills Enhancement for Refugee-Led Organisations and Initiatives'** is an exciting opportunity for refugee community leaders in the Asia Pacific region.

The APNOR and APRRN joint training program provides organizational capacity and professional skill development to support refugee community leaders, and increase their opportunities for greater funding and sustainability.

This course will provide leaders with the foundational building blocks for running a successful and sustainable refugee-led organization. Participants will build technical skills, complete the course with a range of useful resources and tools in place for their organizations, and have the opportunity to network with other organizations operating in the region.

This is a three-part online training course geared toward refugee community leaders and their organizations, as well as refugee community activists interested in starting an initiative.

The training topics will focus on Financial Governance for RLIs, Organizational Development and Management, and Leadership. Modules will run between **October 2022 to end March 2023**, with breaks in between each module.

There will be **funding available** in the form of a stipend for participants and for their respective RLI.

Please note that there is a limited number of spaces for enrollment in this training program, and participation will be based upon an application process.

We are especially interested in applications from women, LGBTIQ+ persons, persons living with disabilities, and others who have commonly experienced social exclusion.

Eligibility:

Individuals interested in applying for this training course need to meet the following criteria:

- Participants are from any of the following countries: Bangladesh, Hong Kong, Indonesia, Malaysia, or Thailand,
 - A working competency in English is necessary;
 - All participants must be able to **commit to all three modules**. This involves participating in 6 hrs/week of training and 3 hrs/week home study; and teaching on **Friday 4pm-7pm ICT**, and **Saturday 1pm-4pm ICT**;
 - All participants must have internet access or be willing to pay for it from the stipend;
 - All participants must have access to a laptop;
 - All participants must have the support of their RLI;
 - Only one person per RLI will be considered.
